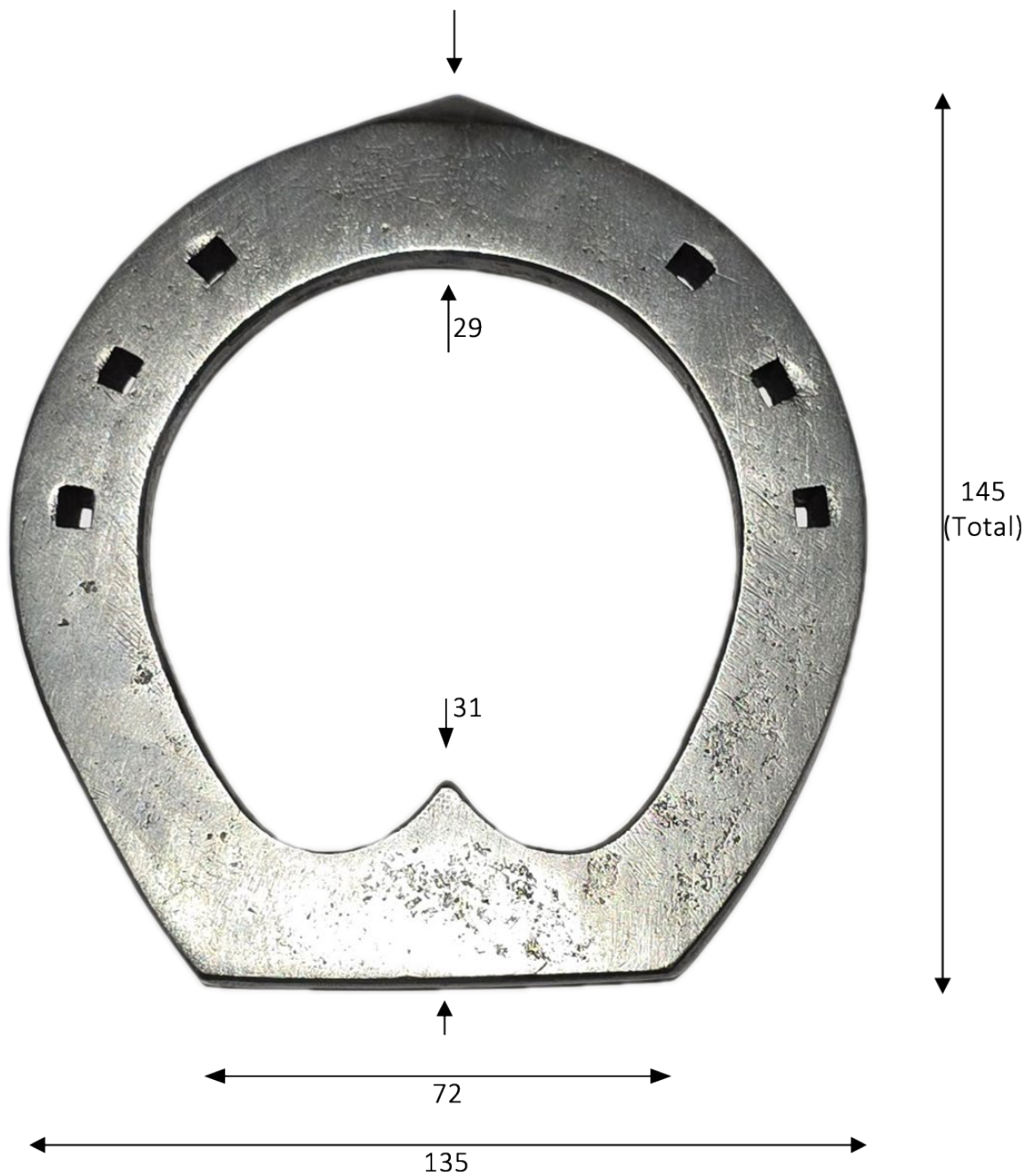
DIVISION 2 – CLASS 1 55 MINUTES

SHOE A: PLAIN STAMPED MASSELOTTE BAR SHOE

ESL 3 20X8X380 (PRECUT, NO CUTTING BEFORE START!) RASP FINISHED

MEASURED IN THE BOX (AS SHOWN BY ARROWS)

THE SHOE IS APPROXIMATELY 6,5MM THICK FINISHED



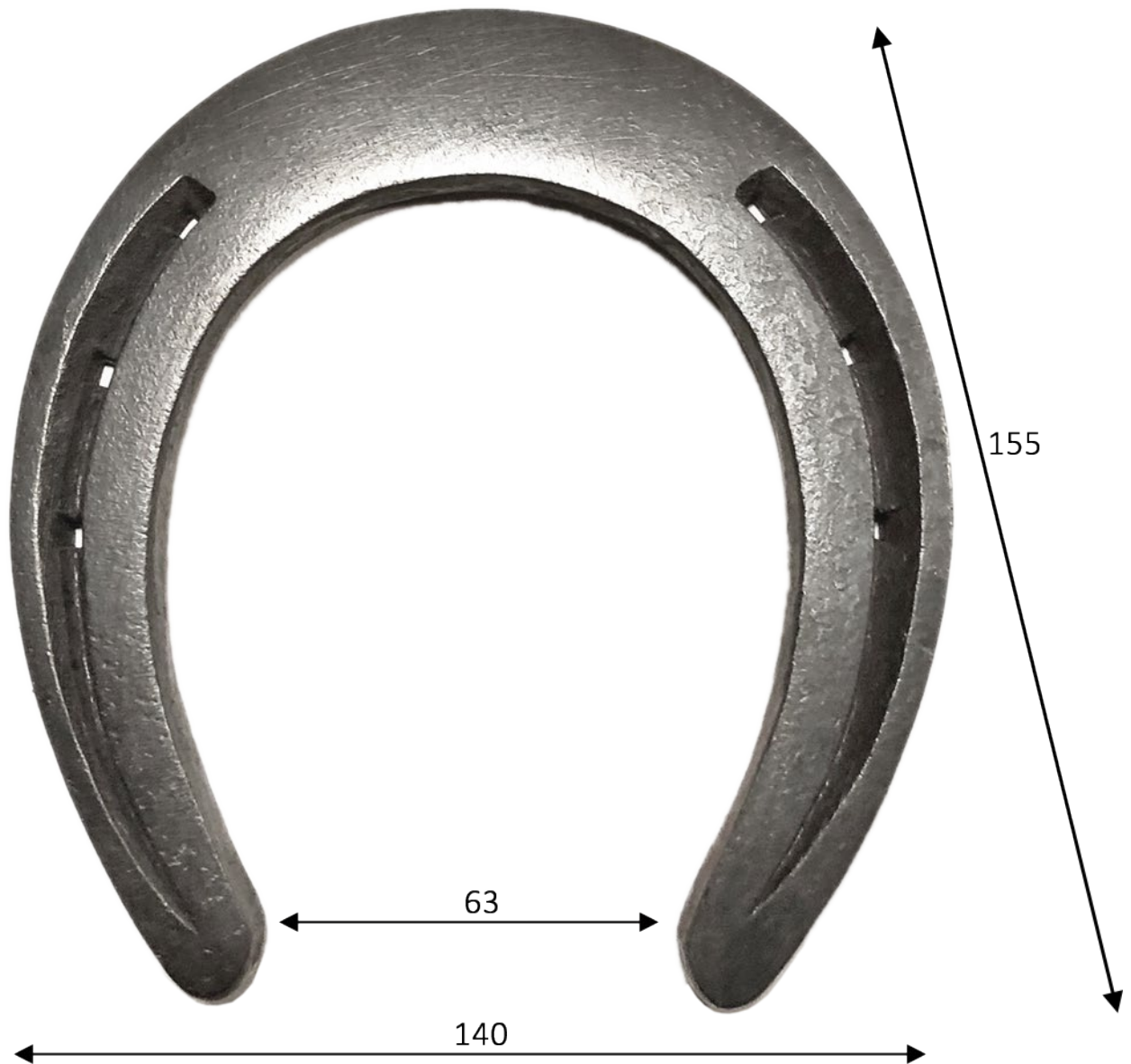


DIVISION 2 – CLASS 1 55 MINUTES

SHOE B: WEDGED FRONT

ESL 5 25X10 RASP FINISHED

TOE THICKNESS 5MM HEEL THICKNESS 14MM



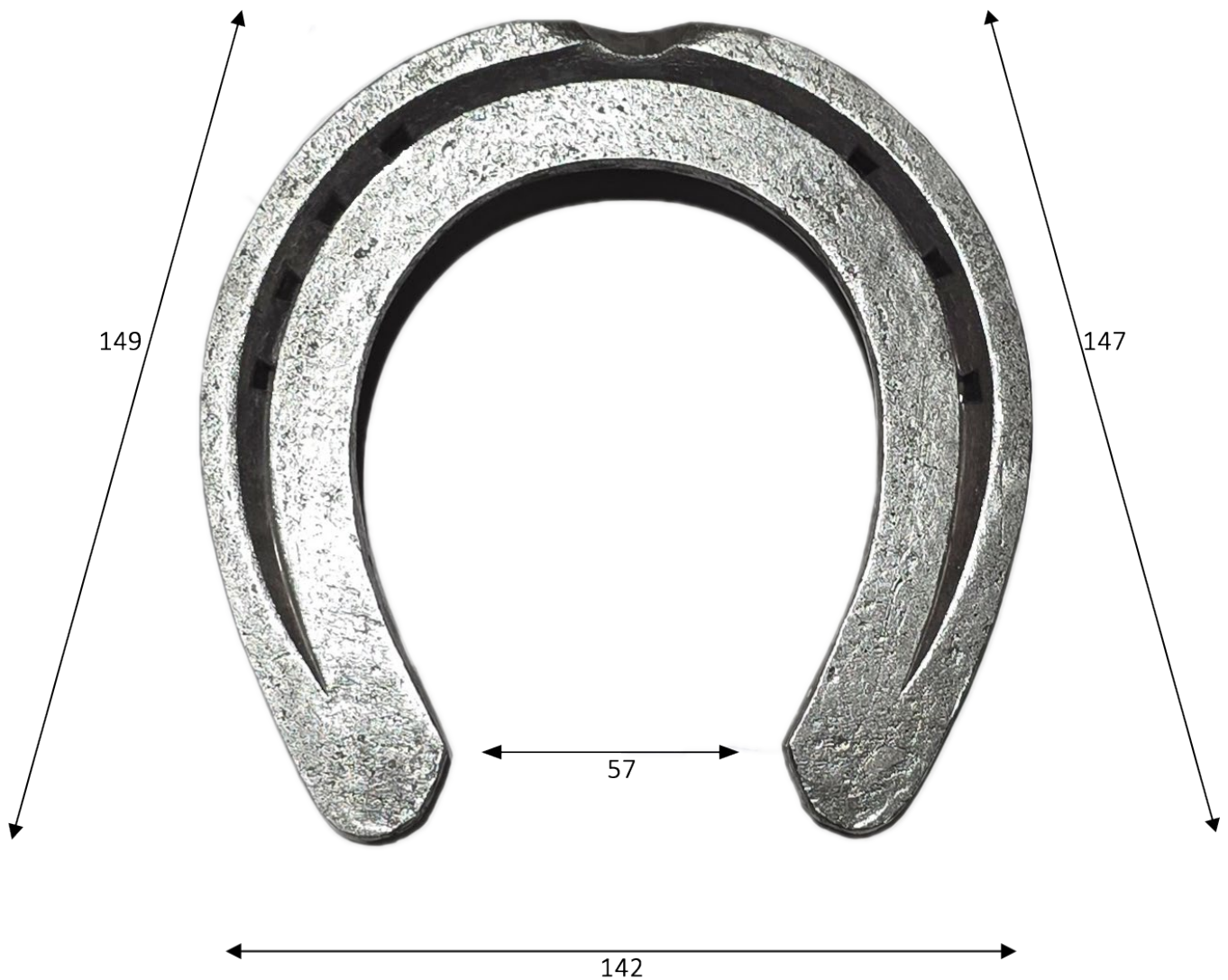


SPECIMEN SHOE: HAMMER FINISHED FULLY FULLERED DEEP SEATED FRONT

ESL 5 25X10

FOOT TO BE SHOD: HIND FOOT OF AN ICELANDIC HORSE. THE STRIKER IS NOT ALLOWED TO LOOK AT THE TRIM OR FIT.

SHOE FOR THE FOOT: CONCAVE, 20X10 OR 22X10 (TO SUIT THE HORSE)





DIVISION 2 – FINAL

75 MINUTES

SHOEING OF 2 FEET

TOP 10 FINAL – SHOEING OF 2 FRONT FEET ON ICELANDIC HORSES.

NO STRIKER IN THE FINALS!

SHOE FOR THE FOOT:

PLAIN STAMPED FRONT SHOES WITH MASSELOTTE TOE CLIP, 8MM SECTION

Rules:

Measuring of shoes:

For the "Measurements" score of the specimens: The width and length will be measured, and 1 point will be withdrawn for each mm off. For the shoes with 2 diagonal length measurements, there will be 0,5 points withdrawn for each mm off. The rest of the measurements are for your information and will be calculated into the forging score.

Use of striker:

A striker is allowed in all classes, besides the finals. In the classes with a foot and a specimen, the striker is not allowed on the horse to look at the trim or fit. Each competitor is responsible for finding a striker. The striker can be changed during the competition. The strikers are only allowed to brush shoes, take them in and out of the forge, try nails, hold the shoe with tongs when the competitor are forging and use the sledge directly on the shoe for levelling/stretching.

The strikers are NOT allowed to shape the shoe or forge on the shoe for the competitor.

Blanks:

Blanks are not allowed.

Sanding:

Sanding is allowed on the feet.

Equipment:

At the arena there are forges, anvils and water buckets available for each competitor. Competitors must bring their own tools, safety glasses, tool table, vice and shoeing equipment. If you need to borrow anything, please get in touch with Katinka (katinkaro@gmail.com).
