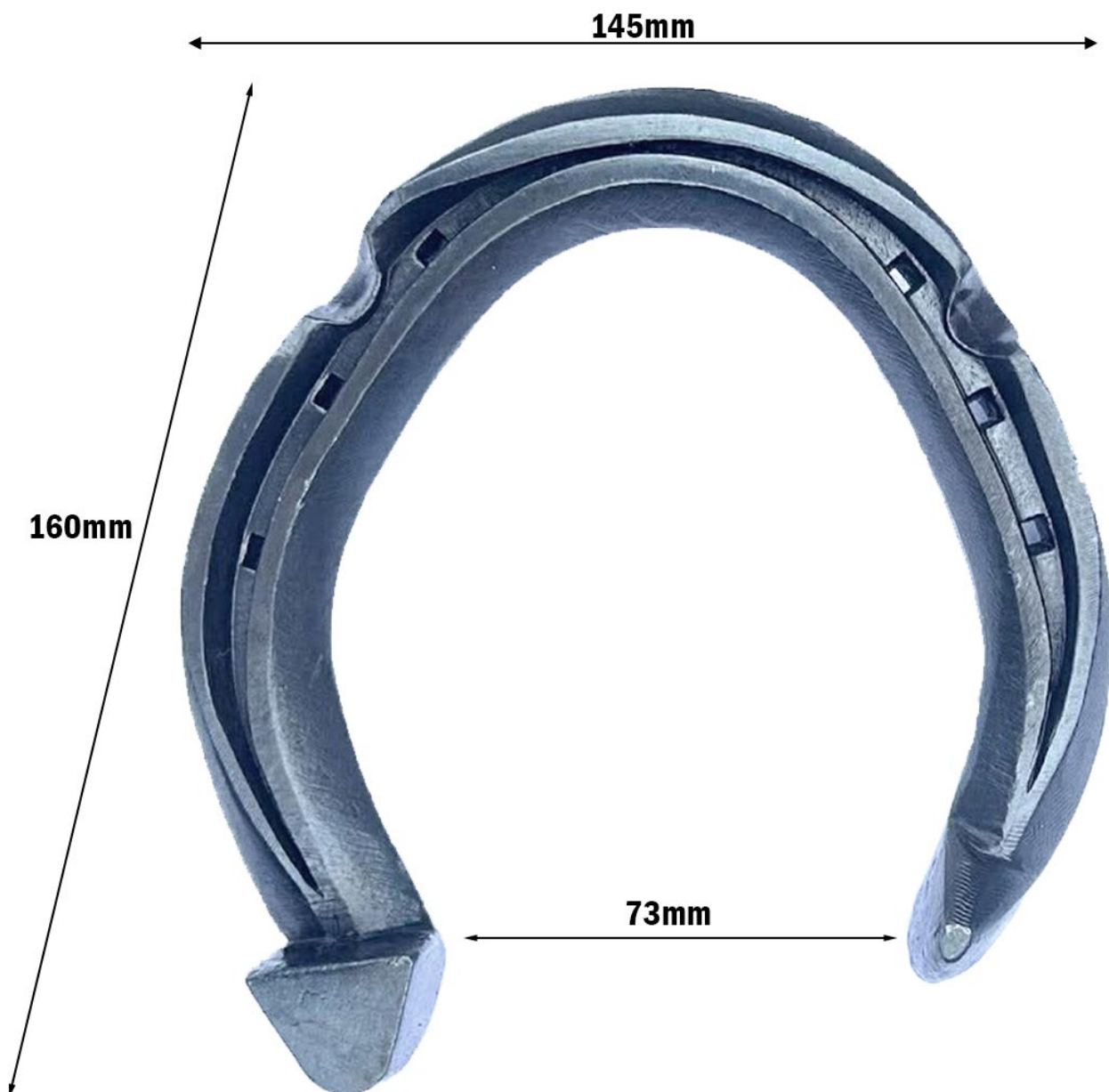
CLASS 1 – ¾ FULLERED HIND SHOD, CONCAVE CAULK & WEDGE SPECIMEN – 70 min

1 Hind foot (icelandic horse) to be shod with ¾ fullered hinds, toe clipped. Section to suit the foot.

Concave caulk & wedge specimen: 7/8 x 7/16» (22x11)

Nails: E6

Rasp finish. Diagonally measured from center toe to outside heel.

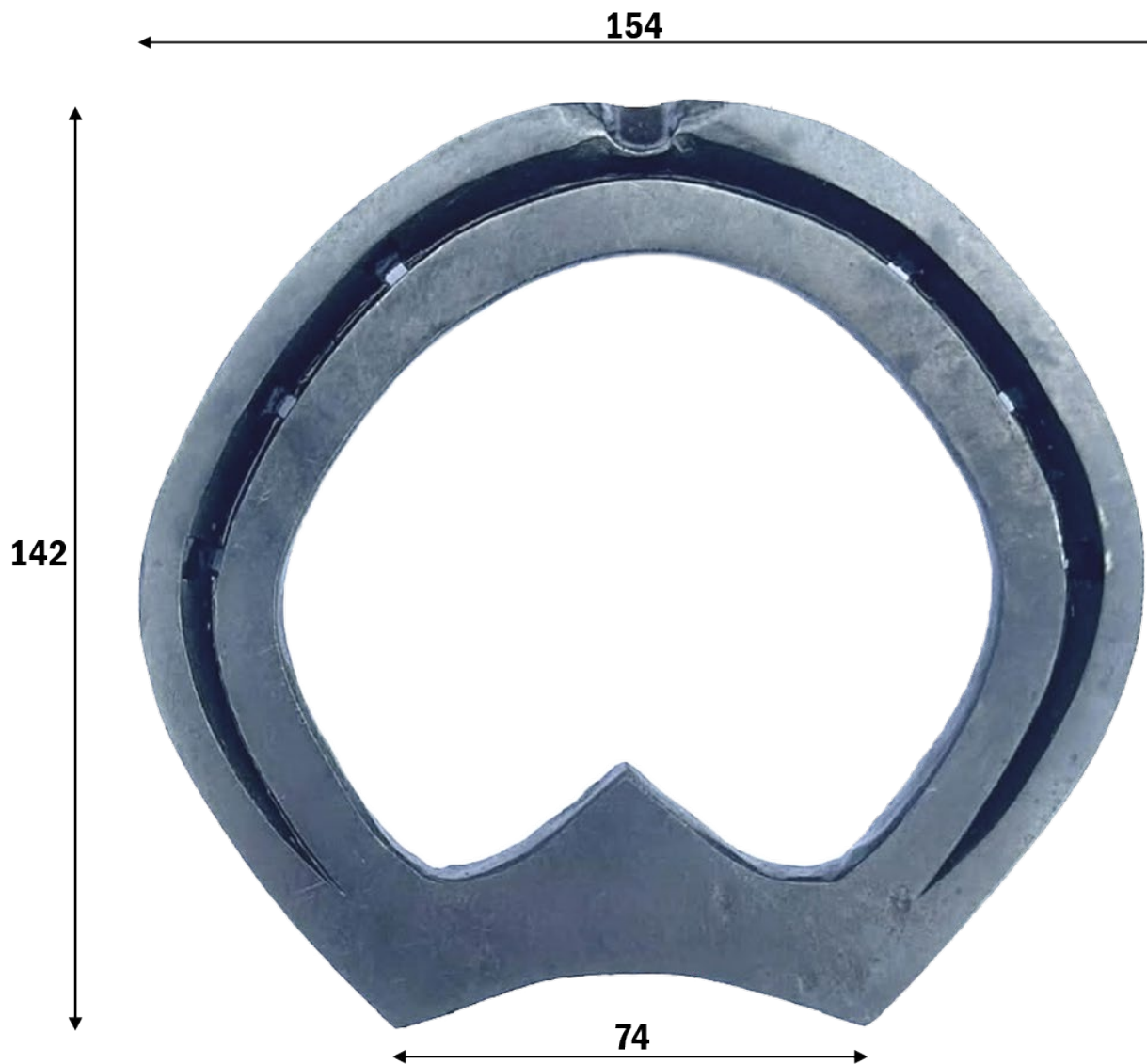




Fully fullered bar shoe: $\frac{3}{4} \times \frac{3}{8}$ » (20x10)

Nails: ESL 4

Rasp finish. Measured in the box





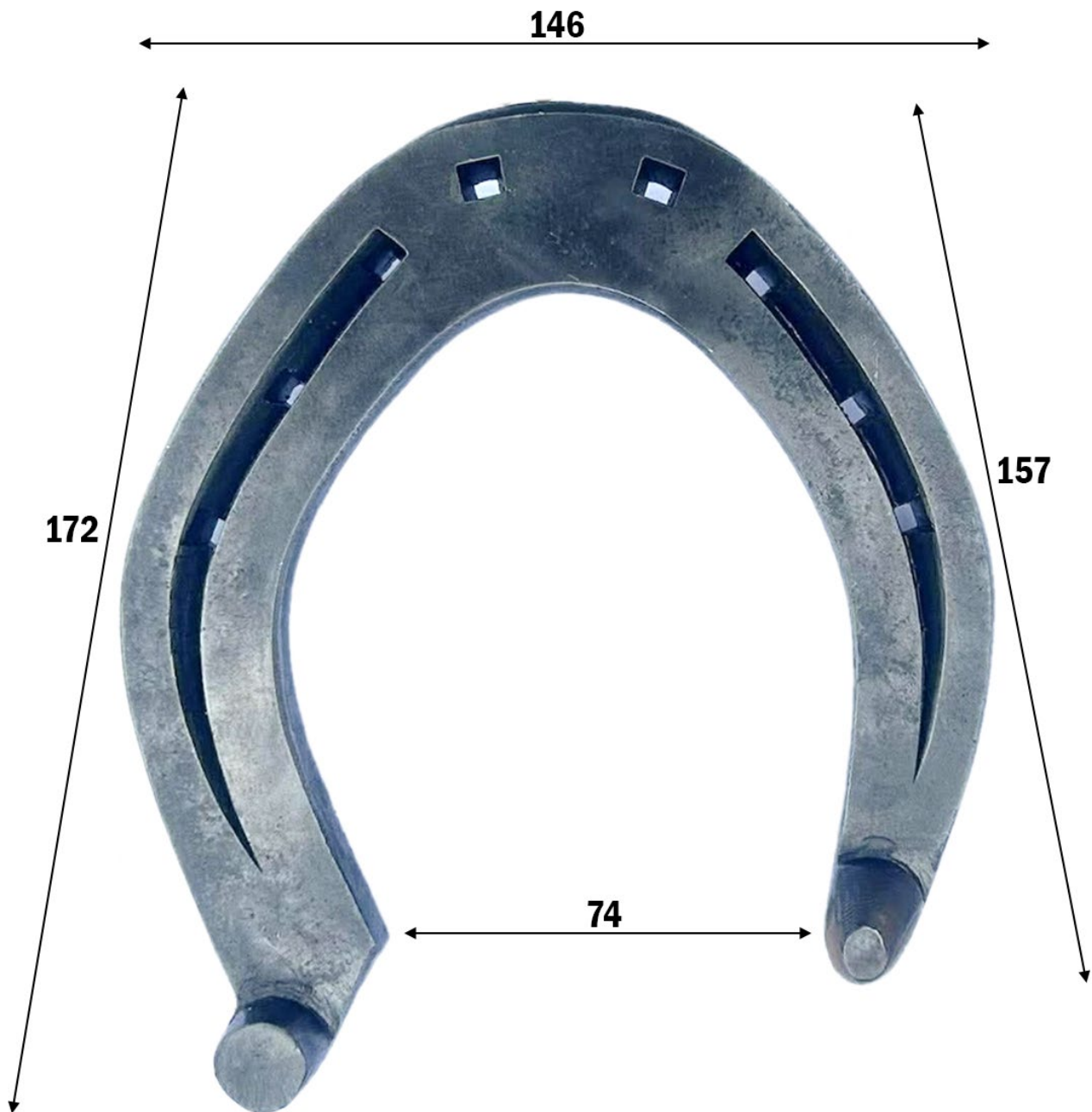
CLASS 2 – FULLY FULLERED BAR SHOE & ITALIAN JUMPER HIND - 55 min

Italian jumper hind: 1 1/4» x 3/8» (290 x 30x10)

Nails: ESL 5

Rasp finish. Measured diagonally from center toe to heels "

Height of heels: 20mm





FINAL DIVISON 1 – 75 MIN

TOP 10

1 Front and 1 hind to be shod with:

Fully fullered masselotte toe clips. Icelandic horse. Section to suit the foot.

75 minutes.

No striker in the final.

Division 1 is open to all competitors.

Rules:

The competition is judged with the Nordic System in Mustad Farrier Portal.

Use of striker: A striker is allowed in all classes, besides the finals. In the classes with a foot and a specimen, the striker is not allowed on the horse to look at the trim or fit. Each competitor is responsible for finding a striker. The striker can be changed during the competition. The strikers are only allowed to brush shoes, take them in and out of the forge, try nails, hold the shoe with tongs when the competitor are forging and use the sledge directly on the shoe/flatter for levelling/stretching. The strikers are NOT allowed to shape the shoe or forge on the shoe for the competitor.

Blanks: Blanks are not allowed.

Sanding: Sanding is allowed on the feet.

Equipment: At the arena there are forges, anvils and water buckets available for each competitor. Competitors must bring their own tools, safety glasses, tool table, vice and shoeing equipment.
