Division 2 – Intermediate

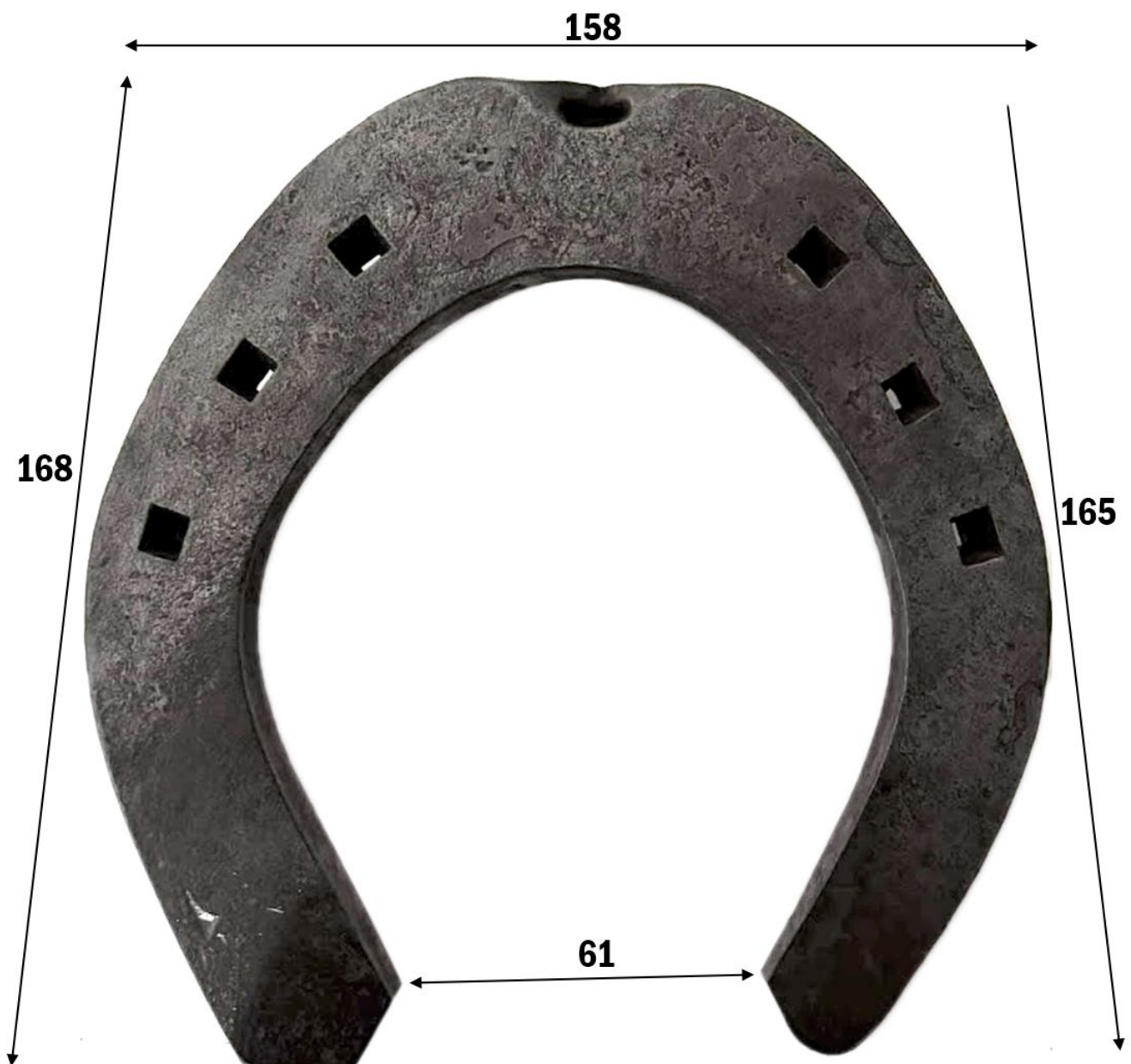
CLASS 1 – FRONT FOOT SHOD, PLAIN STAMP SPECIMEN – 75 min

1 Front foot (icelandic horse) to be shod with concave, regular/pleasure fit. Toe clipped.
Section to suit the foot. Optional clip style.

Plain Stamp specimen: 13 ½» 1 ¼» x 1/2» (343 x 30x12)

Nails: ESL 7

Hammer finish. Heel width outside: 28mm, inside: 20mm





Fully fullered bar shoe: 17» 1» x 3/8» (432 x 25x10)

Nails: ESL 5

Rasp finish. Measured in the box

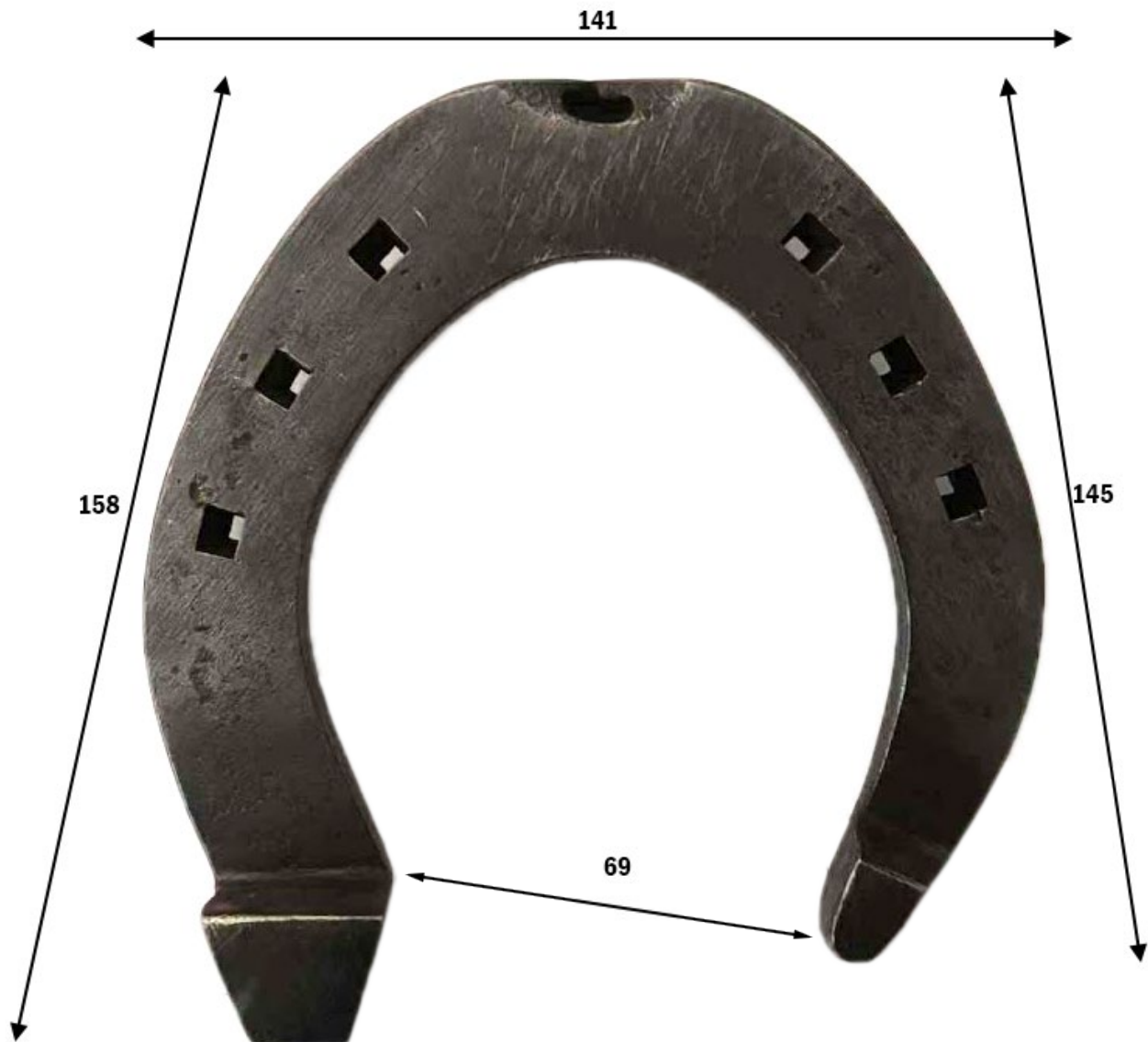
CLASS 2 – FULLY FULLERED BAR SHOE & PLAIN STAMPED ROADSTER – 60 MIN

Plain stamped roadster: 13» 1» x 1/2» (330 x 25x12)

Nails: ESL 5

Rasp finish. Measured diagonally, center toe to outside/inside heel

Heel height: 20mm





FINAL DIVISION 2 – 75 MIN

TOP 10

1 Front and 1 hind to be shod with:

Plain stamp front, $\frac{3}{4}$ fullered hind. Both feet toe clipped. Icelandic horse.

Section to suit the foot. 75 minutes.

No striker in the final.

Division 2 – open to all competitors that during the past 5 years:

- Have not been placed number 1 in division 2
- Have not been placed 1-3 in division 1.

Rules:

The competition is judged with the Nordic System in Mustad Farrier Portal.

Use of striker: A striker is allowed in all classes, besides the finals. In the classes with a foot and a specimen, the striker is not allowed on the horse to look at the trim or fit. Each competitor is responsible for finding a striker. The striker can be changed during the competition. The strikers are only allowed to brush shoes, take them in and out of the forge, try nails, hold the shoe with tongs when the competitor are forging and use the sledge directly on the shoe/flatter for levelling/stretching. The strikers are NOT allowed to shape the shoe or forge on the shoe for the competitor.

Blanks: Blanks are not allowed.

Sanding: Sanding is allowed on the feet.

Equipment: At the arena there are forges, anvils and water buckets available for each competitor. Competitors must bring their own tools, safety glasses, tool table, vice and shoeing equipment.
